You will then be able to pay for parking here or at any car park that uses the scheme - locally that is Chichester District Council car parks. The app can be found on the Google Playstore or the Apple App Store.



You can pay in cash at the machine in the car park or by cash and credit card in person or by phone at the Harbour Office.

- The tariffs shown below apply to both vehicles and trailers, a vehicle with a trailer should display two valid tickets in the windscreen. If paying by MiPermit, select location 711000 for a vehicle or location 710999 for a vehicle with trailer.
- · Charges apply every day, 24 hours a day.
- Vehicles displaying a valid disabled badge do not have to pay for parking. Disabled bays are located under the trees at the western end of the carpark next to the footpath


